Emergency Housing:

If you have not been able to access accommodation through the options above and need housing now, **you will need to contact Work and Income.** We would recommend you visit one of the motels below to **get a quote and take it with you to Work and Income.**

Work and Income are unlikely to approve emergency housing unless you have nowhere to sleep tonight. But, if you know you may be homeless in the next week or so, we would recommend that you make an appointment to see Work and Income so they become familiar with your situation.
